

Reactive Robotics CEO Alexander König gives talk on robots in medical technology at *forum4industry* in the *Deutsches Museum München*

On November 8th 2016 the Deutsches Museum, along with Forum4Industry, UnternehmerTUM and TUMtech invited to an exchange on the topic „Robotic Challenge 4.0 – Was macht der Mensch oder wie stark ist die Macht der Maschine“ („What is the human being doing or how strong is he power of machines“).
